<u>Purpose</u> Created within the Disaster Response-Emergency Operations Account as a depository for funds allocated for assistance to eligible higher education entities. To reimburse eligible higher education entities for disaster assistance programs, as specified. To provide for the repair, cleanup, and reconstruction of damaged public facilities. To provide matching funds required under federal disaster assistance programs. To provide other assistance necessary, as specified for losses or expenses related to earthquake activity that began on October 1, 1987.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> California State University/Org 6610		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> An appropriation of \$15,300,000 from the Disaster Response-Emergency Operations Account that was transferred from the Special Fund for Economic Uncertainties.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Per Government Code 8690.8 (5) (f) any unused funds shall revert to the Disaster Response-Emergency Operations Account (Fund 0375).		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Chapter 1, Statutes of 1987, Section 3, provides the money allocated to the fund is continuously appropriated.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which will be counted in an always excluded fund, the Disaster Response-Emergency Operations Account (0375), and should not be double counted.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 158, Statutes of 2005 (SB 966) abolished this fund, effective January 1, 2006.
