<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To provide funding for the purchase of new relocatable child care facilities for lease to school districts and contracting agencies who provide child care and development services. The Superintendent of Public Instruction may transfer state funds appropriated for child care facilities into this fund for allocation to school districts and contracting agencies for the purchase, transportation, and installation of facilities for replacement and expansion of capacity.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Education/Org 6110		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> General fund transfer and lease payments.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b>		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> This fund is continuously appropriated.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded-</b> This is a major revenue source which is transferred from another fund, the General Fund, which has already been counted in an included fund and should not be double counted.		
<b><u>Historical Comments</u></b> This fund was administratively abolished when reclassified to Non-Governmental, Working Capital/Revolving Funds on 9/2/98 and renumbered to Fund 0620.
