<u>Legal Title</u> Surface Impoundment Assessment Account

<u>Purpose</u> A depository for fees charged persons for discharging hazardous wastes into a surface impoundment and for related exemption and penalty fees. This act added Section 25122.7 and Article 9.5 (commencing with Section 25208) to Chapter 6.5 of the Health and Safety Code. Section 25208.3 of the Health and Safety Code authorizes the State Water Resources Control Board to establish a fee schedule, to collect fees from persons discharging liquid hazardous wastes into surface impoundment, and to deposit the collected fees into the account.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> State Water Resources Control Board/Org 3940		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Fees for discharging hazardous wastes into surface impoundments.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Related administration costs for the state board and regional quality control boards.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Section 25208.3(d) of the Health and Safety Code provides that the account be used, upon appropriation, for the purposes specified.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use and purposes for which they are used.
