<u>Purpose</u> This fund is used to fulfill the terms and conditions set forth in the December 1998 Stringfellow Site Agreement and the subsequent 2002 Consent Decree pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25330.6.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Toxic Substances Control/Org 3960		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Funds recovered in connection with the Stringfellow Superfund Site Agreement and any related interest earned.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25330.4 (f) (1) all assets, liabilities, and surplus in this fund shall be transferred to, and become part of, a subaccount (fund 8083) for expenditure for the same purpose.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> These funds are available upon appropriation by the Legislature. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25330.2, funds are available for encumbrance for three fiscal years, including the fiscal year in which the funds are appropriated.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund.		

Comments/Historical Information

Chapter 66, Statutes of 1999 (AB 1103) created this fund. Health and Safety Code section 25330.6 (e) states that this section shall become inoperative on July 1, 2013, and, as of January 1, 2014, is repealed, unless a later enacted statute, that becomes operative on or before January 1, 2014 deletes or extends the dates on which it becomes inoperative and is repealed.

Chapter 178, Statutes of 2007 (SB 85) added Health and Safety Code section 25330.4 (f) (1) and (2) to create a subaccount (fund 8083) in the state account as the successor fund to this fund.
