<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To deposit fees paid by subscribers and solicitors in connection with the “do not call list”, as maintained by the Attorney General.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Justice/Org 0820		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fees paid by telephone solicitors and subscribers.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> The money in this fund is available by annual appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> This fund is abolished per Chapter 779, Statutes of 2003, section 3 (SB 33) effective January 1, 2003.
