<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To support the Permanent Amusement Ride Inspection Program		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Industrial Relations/Org 7350		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fees and civil penalties collected from operators/owners of permanent amusement rides.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Funds are available upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from penalties; as well as, the initial amount to startup this fund is derived from a General Fund loan.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> This fund was initially created administratively and subsequently included in the 2000/01 Budget Act trailer bill. Initial funding from the General Fund loan.  This fund is repealed as of 1/1/2008 by its own terms.
