<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Continuously appropriated

<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> This fund was originally created administratively based on a proposed trailer bill to the 2000/01 Budget Bill. The trailer bill did not pass so the fund is now abolished per Government Code section 13306(b).
