<u>Purpose</u> To pay for the state's share of the nonfederal costs of flood control and flood prevention projects adopted and authorized.		
<u>Administering Agency/Org Code</u> Department of Water Resources/Org 3860		
<u>Revenue Source</u> Money transferred from the Flood Protection Account (Fund 6002).		
<u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> This fund is continuously appropriated.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which is already been counted or will be counted in an always excluded fund, Flood Protection Account (Fund 6002), and should not be double counted; as well as, this fund is also derived from a Bond Fund.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> This fund was established by the passage of Proposition 13 on the March 2000 ballot.
