<u>Authority and Purpose</u> The California National Guard Military Museum Fund was administratively created for the deposit of private donations and grants to be used to create and maintain a Museum for the California National Guard.		
<u>Administering Agency</u> Military Department/Org 8940		
<u>Major Sources</u> Private donations of funds or property for the support and improvement of the museum, monies received from the sale of excess properties donated and grants.		
<u>Disposition</u> Support and improvement of the California National Guard Military Museum.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Continuously appropriated.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded - - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.		
<u>Historical Comments</u> Due to fund inactivity, the California National Guard Military Museum Fund has been administratively abolished in accordance with Government Code Section 13306(b), effective February 23, 2005.
