<u>Legal Title</u> Environmental Protection Trust Fund

<u>Purpose</u> A depository for fees and penalties collected from owners or operators of above-ground petroleum storage tanks for specified purposes related to spills or releases occurring on or after January 1, 1990. The legislation was in response to the April 1988 oil spill at the Shell Martinez Refinery and to the fact that federal regulation of above-ground tanks was perceived as inadequate.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> State Water Resources Control Board/Org 3940		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Fees and penalties paid by owners or operators of tank facilities as well as cleanup and oversight expenses and penalties collected from Shell as a result of the Martinez oil spill.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25270.11 (c), all moneys remaining in the Environmental Protection Trust Fund that have not been expended, as of June 1, 2013, shall be deposited into the Unified Program Account (Fund 0028).		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 626, Statutes of 2007 added Health and Safety Code section 25270.11, effective January 1, 2008, inoperative July 1, 2011, and repealed January 1, 2012. Chapter 861, Statutes of 2011 abolished this fund and transferred the remaining balance as of June 1, 2013 to Fund 0028.
