Chapter 759, Statutes of 1997 changed the parent fund title to Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians Fund. The Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians administers this fund within the Department of Consumer Affairs. Effective October 2015, administering agency change from the Department of Consumer Affairs – Regulatory Boards/Org 1110 to the current organization. Chapter 510, Statutes 2015 (AB 179) abolished the Fund effective July 1, 2016. | | |
