<u>Purpose</u> To provide moneys to cities, counties and cities, and counties to defray costs of enforcing local housing code provisions, to finance rehabilitation programs for persons and families of low and moderate income and to prevent or minimize the displacement of tenants and homeowners as a result of local code enforcement activities.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Finance/Org 8860		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Appropriations from the General Fund.		
<u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Continuously appropriated.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already counted in an included fund, the General Fund (0001), and should not be double counted; as well as, this fund is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal).		
<u>Historical Comments</u> This fund was abolished pursuant to Government Code section 13306(b), effective July 23, 2011.
