<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> State Responsibility Area Fire Prevention Fund

<b><u>Purpose</u></b> Monies in the fund shall be available to the board and the department to expend for fire prevention activities specified in Public Resources Code section 4214(d) that benefit the owners of structures within a state responsibility area who are required to pay the fire prevention fee. The fund may also be used to cover the costs of administering this chapter and to cover all startup costs incurred over a period not to exceed two years.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Forestry and Fire Protection/ Org 3540		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> State responsibility area fire prevention fees.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> The money in this fund is available upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 741, Statutes of 2003 (SB 1049) originally created this fund. Chapter 219, Statutes of 2004 (SB 1112) repealed Section 4140 related to the State Responsibility Area Fire Protection Fund. This fund is abolished effective August 11, 2004 due to an urgency clause in statute. Chapter 8, Statutes of 2011 (ABX1 29) recreated the fund title as the State Responsibility Area Fire Prevention Fund.
