<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> Residential and Outpatient Program Licensing Fund

<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To support the licensing and certification activities of the department.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Health Care Services/Org Code 4260		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> All fees, fines, and penalties collected from residential and outpatient programs.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 22, Statutes of 2013 (AB 75) changed the Administering Agency from the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs/Org 4200 to the Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260 effective July 1, 2013.
