<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Fees		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Labor Code section 1308.11 (b), any moneys, assets, liabilities, revenues, expenditures, and encumbrances of this fund shall be transferred to the Labor Enforcement and Compliance Fund (Fund 3152).		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to provide direct services or products to the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 31, Statutes of 2016, Section 179 transfers this fund to Fund 3152 effective June 27, 2016.
