<u>Purpose</u> The bill would require that the department develop and implement the campaign established under the bill only if the Director of Finance determines that sufficient private donations, as defined to be at least \$12,000,000, have been collected and deposited in this account.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs/Org 4200		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Private Donations		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> The Legislature may appropriate moneys in the account for subsequent fiscal years in the annual Budget Act or any other act.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 662, Statutes of 2006 (SB 1500) created this fund.
