**BILL SUMMARY: Health: Underserved Communities**

This bill would add federally qualified health centers (FQHCs) operated by a county to the list of clinics required to report specified demographic data to the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD).

**FISCAL SUMMARY**

The OSHPD estimates that the workload associated with collecting and reviewing the additional 100 to 150 FQHC reports would require an additional 0.5 Staff Services Analyst at an annual cost of \$32,000 from the California Health Data and Planning Fund. Any request for resources would be evaluated as part of the annual budget process.

**COMMENTS**

The Department of Finance is neutral on this bill. This bill would allow OSHPD to collect and report on demographic information on FQHC clinics consistent with the data made available for other non-profit clinics in the state. Because many FQHC's are county run and licensed by their respective counties, they are currently excluded from the requirement on clinics to report data to OSHPD.
