Subject: Long Range Property Management Plan

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code (HSC) section 34191.5 (b), the City of South Pasadena Successor Agency (Agency) submitted a Long Range Property Management Plan (LRPMP) to the California Department of Finance (Finance) on August 16, 2013. Finance has completed its review of the LRPMP, which may have included obtaining clarification for various items.

The Agency received a Finding of Completion on April 26, 2013. Further, based on our review and application of the law, we are approving the Agency's disposition of the property listed on the LRPMP.

In accordance with HSC section 34191.4 (a), upon receiving a Finding of Completion from Finance and approval of the LRPMP, all real property and interests in real property shall be transferred to the Community Redevelopment Property Trust Fund of the Agency, unless that property is subject to the requirements of an existing enforceable obligation. Pursuant to HSC section 34191.3 the approved LRPMP shall govern, and supersede all other provisions relating to, the disposition and use of all the real property assets of the former redevelopment agency.

Agency actions taken pursuant to a Finance approved LRPMP are subject to oversight board (OB) approval per HSC section 34181 (f). Any subsequent OB actions addressing the Agency's implementation of the approved LRPMP should be submitted to Finance for approval.
