Subject: Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule

This letter supersedes the California Department of Finance's (Finance) Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) letter dated November 09, 2015. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code (HSC) section 34177 (m), the Colusa City Successor Agency (Agency) submitted a Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS 15-16B) to Finance on September 30, 2015, for the period of January 1 through June 30, 2016. Finance issued a ROPS determination letter on November 09, 2015. Subsequently, the Agency requested a Meet and Confer session on one or more of the determinations made by Finance. The Meet and Confer session was held on November 18, 2015.

Based on our review and application of the law, Finance continues to deny the entirety of your ROPS 15-16B. HSC section 34187 (c) states that if a former redevelopment agency (RDA) was not allocated property tax revenue prior to February 1, 2012, the Agency shall, no later than November 1, 2015 submit to the Oversight Board (OB) a request to formally dissolve the Agency. The OB and Finance each have 30 days to review and approve the request to dissolve. According to documentation provided by the Colusa County Auditor-Controller (Controller), the former RDA did not receive property tax revenue prior to February 1, 2012. In fact, the first tax year the Agency experienced positive growth was fiscal year 2013-2014. As such, the Agency is subject to the requirements set forth in HSC section 34187 (c) and should formally dissolve prior to the ROPS 15-16B period.

The Agency's maximum approved Redevelopment Property Tax Trust Fund (RPTTF) distribution for the reporting period is zero.
