Dear Ms. Weaver:

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code (HSC) section 34177 (l) (2) (C), the City of Turlock Successor Agency submitted a Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) to the California Department of Finance (Finance) for the period January through June, 2012.

The ROPS submitted to Finance is incomplete, and therefore, not approved for making obligation payments. The ROPS submitted indicates multiple funding sources for individual line items and cannot be reviewed further. Please see the example provided in Exhibit 6 of http://www.dof.ca.gov/assembly_bills_26-27/view.php. Please resubmit a revised oversight board-approved ROPS for the period January through June 2012. You may submit the revised ROPS to Redevelopment_Administration@dof.ca.gov.

As authorized by HSC section 34179 (h), Finance is returning your ROPS for your reconsideration. This action will cause the ROPS to be ineffective until Finance approval.

Finance may continue to review items on the ROPS and identify additional issues. We will provide separate notice if we are requesting further modifications to the ROPS. Our intent is to provide an approval notice for each ROPS prior to the June 1 property tax distribution date.
