<u>Purpose</u> The fund is to administer and enforce the Public Utilities Commission's jurisdiction to regulate the rates of transportation agencies carrying property for compensation.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of California Highway Patrol/Org 2720		
<u>Major Sources</u> A specified amount of the increase fees from the Highway Carrier's Act shall be allocated from the Transportation Rate Fund.		
<u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u> The funds will be used to facilitate the administration and enforcement of acts which regulate the safe and lawful operating practices of highway carriers throughout the state.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Public Utilities Code, Section 4006 provides five (\$5) dollars from the registration or renewal fees from each registration or renewal paid by private carriers of property pursuant to this section shall be allocated on a quarterly basis to the Commercial Motor Carrier Safety Enforcement Fund.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded.
