<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> Narcotic Treatment Program Licensing Trust Fund

<b><u>Purpose</u></b> A depository for licensure fees collected from the providers of narcotic treatment services for the costs associated with narcotic treatment licensure actions and inspection of narcotic treatment programs.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Licensure fees collected from the providers of narcotic treatment services.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> If funds remain, a percentage of the excess funds shall be annually rebated to the licensees based on the percentage of their licensing fee to the total amount of fees collected by the department.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Moneys in the fund shall be available when appropriated by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 1329, Statutes of 1984 created this fund in Health and Safety Code section 11876 (c). Chapter 455, Statutes of 1995 changed the fund title from Methadone Program Licensing Trust Fund to Narcotic Treatment Program Licensing Trust Fund. Chapter 862, Statutes of 2004 changed the legislative location of this fund from Health and Safety Code section 11876 (c) to 11839.3 (c). Chapter 22, Statutes of 2013 (AB 75) Section 49 changed the Administering Agency from the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs/Org 4200 to the Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260 effective June 27, 2013.
