<b><u>Purpose</u></b> Money in the fund is to be used by the Coachella Valley Mountains Conservancy for purposes related to the preservation of land in the Coachella Valley.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Coachella Valley Mountains Conservancy/Org 3850		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Revenue, money, grants, fees, rents, royalties, goods, services, donations, bequests, or gifts of any interest in real property from any public agency, private entity, or person.  Money borrowed from an entity that is represented on the conservancy's governing board.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> Always Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from revenue, money, grants, fees, rents, royalties, goods, services, donations, bequests, or gifts of any interest in real property from any public agency, private entity, or person.
