<u>Purpose</u> Parks and resources improvement and administrative costs allocable to the bond funded projects as set forth in accordance with this chapter.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Parks and Recreation/Org 3790		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Proceeds from the sale of bonds.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Appropriated by the Legislature unless otherwise specified.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded — Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Bond Fund.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> The bond was passed on the ballot of the March 7, 2000, statewide general election.
