<u>Purpose</u> This fund was created for the deposit of fees collected by the Department of Justice for providing state summary criminal history information pursuant to this and other code sections. This fund pays for expenditures incurred by the Department of Justice for providing state summary criminal information.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Justice/Org 0820		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Fees		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this account upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> This fund is available upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to provide direct services to the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 1377, Statutes of 1972 as provided in Penal Code section 11105(e) established a special account in the General Fund. Through usage, this account has become known as the fingerprint fees account. This account was initially appropriated without regard to fiscal years; however, amendment by Chapter 1222, Statutes of 1975 made this account available for expenditure when appropriated by the Legislature.
