<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> Firearm Safety Account		
<b><u>Legal Citation/Authority</u></b> Chapter 711, Statutes of 2010 (SB 1080) Penal Code section 23690		
<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>GAAP Basis</u></b> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>Legal Basis</u></b> Governmental/General Fund Special Accounts	
<b><u>Purpose</u></b> This fund will be used for the support of department program costs related to this act, including the establishment, maintenance, and upgrading of related data base systems and public rosters.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Justice/ Org 0820		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Purchase fees not to exceed \$1.00 charged by dealers for each firearm purchased or transferred.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues 1) have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used; 2) are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 246 Statutes of 1999 created the Firearm Safety Account under Penal Code section 12088.9. Chapter 711, Statutes of 2010, section 10 repeals the Penal Code section 12088.9, as of January 1, 2012 and moves the fund to Penal Code section 23690, operative January 1, 2012.
