<u>Legal Title</u> Diesel Fuel Trust Fund		
<u>Legal Citation/Authority</u> Health and Safety Code, Section 43702 Chapter 781, Statutes of 1994		
<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue	<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Governmental/Other Governmental Cost Funds	
<u>Purpose</u> This fund will be used to deposit revenues received from variance fees imposed upon manufacturers who receive a variance from standards for the content of diesel fuel adopted by the Air Resources Board. The money was fully expended in 1995-96 to reimburse owners of diesel fuel powered engines and equipment for damages caused by the reformulated diesel fuel.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Air Resources Board/Org 3900		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Revenues received from any variance fees imposed on manufacturers of diesel fuel.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Administrative costs not to exceed \$300,000 and to reimburse owners of diesel fuel powered engines and equipment for damage to fuel injection system components.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> This number was originally assigned to the Motor Vehicle Account which was changed to 0044 per Chapter 669, Statutes of 1978. Fund was abolished per Government Code section 13306(b) on December 17, 2012.
