<b><u>Purpose</u></b> Establish a program for career advancement to assist eligible state employees to participate in educational programs that will enhance the personal growth and career development of employees in state government.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Personnel Administration/Org 8380		
<b><u>Revenue Source</u></b> Transfer of \$200,000 from the General Fund. Any additional funds for subsequent fiscal years shall be transferred from the amount appropriated in the annual Budget Act for employee compensation.		
<b><u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Expended without regard to fiscal years through June 30, 2001, unless extended by statute.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> —The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted in an included fund, the General Fund (0001), and should not be double counted.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Government Code section 19995.5 is repealed as of June 30, 2001, by its own terms. This fund is abolished effective June 30, 2001.
