<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To fund administrative costs and to make payments to purchasers of newly constructed residential structures and housing sponsors of housing developments. Expenditures are made for five fiscal years beginning in 1998/99 and ending December 31, 2002		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Housing and Community Development/Org 2240		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Transfer from the General Fund (\$160 million)</li> <li>• Transfer from the Self-Help Housing Fund (0813), pursuant to Chapter 26, Statutes of 2002 (\$50 million)</li> </ul>		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> This fund is continuously appropriated.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded-</b> This is a major revenue source, which is transferred from another fund, the General Fund, which has already been counted in an included fund and should not be double counted.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 407 Statutes of 1998 originally created this fund. Administrative Action: The administering organization for this fund was changed from 1760-DGS to 2240-HCD, effective 10/30/03.
