<u>Purpose</u> Chapter 1463, Statutes of 1986 created the AIDS Vaccine Victims Compensation Fund to pay damages for personal injuries caused by an AIDS vaccine that is sold in or delivered in California, as specified.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> The fund shall be funded wholly by a surcharge on the sale of an FDA-approved AIDS vaccine in California in an amount to be determined by the State Department of Health Care Services.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Section 199.50 of the Health and Safety Code provides that the fund is wholly funded by a surcharge levied on the sale of each unit of the vaccine sold or delivered, administered, or dispensed in California. Therefore, claims against the fund are contingent upon the existing resources of the fund and in no case shall the state be liable for any claims in excess of the resources in the fund.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> This fund was created in Health and Safety Code section 199.50. Chapter 415, Statutes of 1995 (SB 1360) reorganized the code and moved this creation language to Health and Safety Code section 121270 (a). This fund was abolished pursuant to Government Code section 13306(b), effective July 23, 2011.
