<b><u>Purpose</u></b> Funds paid into the Travel Seller Fund shall be used by the Department of Justice in carrying out and enforcing the provisions of Article 2.6 (commencing with Section 17550), including, but not limited to, the payment of salaries of Department of Justice personnel, , contractors, or consultants, and the dissemination of information, including consumer education regarding Article 2.6 and Article 2.7 (commencing with Section 17550.35).		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Justice/Org 0820		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fines, penalties, and fees, including late fees collected pursuant to this article, or any moneys collected for a violation of this article or Article 2.7.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Continuously appropriated		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> This number was originally used for the Constitution Inspector's Registration Board Fund which was abolished per Chapter 1416, Statutes of 1978. This fund will be repealed January 1, 1999 by its own terms. Chapter 1123, Statutes of 1994 created this fund. Chapter 196, Statutes of 2003 substituted "fines, penalties, and fees, including late fees..." for "fines and fees, including late fees..."
