<u>Purpose</u> To undertake environmental enhancement and mitigation projects, not to exceed \$5 million for any single grant, that are directly or indirectly related to the environmental impact of modifying existing transportation facilities or for the design, construction, or expansion of new transportation facilities.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Secretary of the Natural Resources Agency/Org 0540		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Annual allocations of \$7 million		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Streets and Highways Code section 164.56 states that it is the intent of the Legislature to allocate \$7 million annually to this fund.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from an Included Fund, State Highway Account, State Transportation Fund (0042), which has already been counted and should not be double counted.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 106, Statutes of 1989, created the Environmental Enhancement and Mitigation Demonstration Program Fund. Chapter 739, Statutes of 1999 (SB117) removed the word Demonstration from the fund title. Chapter 359, Statutes of 2013 (SB 99) changed the annual allocations to the fund from \$10 million to \$7 million. December 2013 revision changed the Administering Agency from the Department of Transportation, California Transportation Commission/Org 2660 to Secretary of the Natural Resources Agency/Org 0540.
