<u>Legal Title</u> Energy Account		
<u>Legal Citation/Authority</u> Chapter 899, Statutes of 1980 Public Resources Code section 26401		
<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Governmental/Other Governmental Cost Funds	
<u>Purpose</u> Support for energy projects and programs approved by the Legislature per Public Resources Code Section 26401(c). Money in the account may be appropriated by the Legislature solely for energy projects from the Energy and Resources Fund.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> So many agencies are concerned with expenditures from this account that a detailed listing is not practical in this outline. However, the list is available in the annual Governor's Budget and the State Controller's Annual Report.		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Allocations transferred from the Energy and Resources Fund (see Fund No. 188).		
<u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u> This fund has been administratively abolished in accordance with Government Code 13306 (b). The remaining fund balance has been transferred to Fund 0188, Energy and Resources Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Section 26401(d) of the Public Resources Code provides that all appropriations from the Energy Account shall be made by the annual Budget Bill.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded- The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted in an always excluded fund, the Energy and Resources Fund (#0188), and should not be double counted.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> This fund was administratively abolished in September 2002, in accordance with Government Code 13306 (b). The remaining fund balance has been transferred to Fund 0188, Energy and Resources Fund.
