<b><u>Purpose</u></b> Promote and assist in rural development efforts across the state.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> California Trade and Commerce Agency/ Org 2920		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Monetary gifts, grants, donations, and transfers from other funds.		
<b><u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Funds available upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – the major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted in an included fund, the General Fund (0001), and should not be double counted.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 229, Statutes of 2003 (AB 1757) repealed Section 15373.114 related to deposits into the Rural Development Fund. This fund is abolished effective January 1, 2004.
