<u>Purpose</u> To support the operations and maintenance of the Northern California Veterans Cemetery.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Veterans Affairs/Org 8955		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Pursuant to Military and Veterans Code section 1400 through 1403, revenue sources are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Annual appropriation of \$450,000 with total expenditures not to exceed \$600,000 per fiscal year. • Fee of \$500 for each spouse or child interred in the cemetery. • Cash donations for the maintenance and repair of the facility. 		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the legislature in the annual Budget Act.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted in an included fund, the General Fund (0001), and should not be double counted.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> February 2012 revision changed the administering agency organization code from 8955 to 8950. August 2014 revision changed the administering agency organization code from 8950 to 8955.
