<u>Purpose</u> This fund was administratively created for the proposed merger of the State Police into the California Highway Patrol. All agencies will be assessed fees for the services of the State Police to cover their operational costs when they are merged with the California Highway Patrol.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> California Highway Patrol/ Org 2720		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Fee assessments to all state agencies to cover the cost of the State Police services.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Cost of the operational of the State Police within the Highway Patrol		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Continuously appropriated		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> <i>Always Excluded</i> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Working Capital and Revolving Fund.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> The operations of the State Police were previously funded from fund 0397 the California State Police Fund. Fund 0246 Protective Services Fund was created for the merger of CHP and State Police in the 1995-96 Governor's Budget. Fund was abolished per Government Code section 13306(b) on December 17, 2012.
