<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> Domestic Violence Fund		
<b><u>Legal Citation/Authority</u></b> Chapter 28x, Statutes of 1994 Penal code section 1203.097 (a) (5)		
<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>GAAP Basis</u></b> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>Legal Basis</u></b> Governmental/Other Governmental Cost Funds	
<b><u>Purpose</u></b> One-half of the money was to be distributed to the counties and one-half to support statewide training programs. Subsequently, Chapter 707/98 abolished this fund and created two (2) new funds effective January 1, 1999. (See Fund 0641 and 0642)		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Org. Code</u></b> Organization Code - 0820/Department of Justice		
<b><u>Revenue Sources</u></b> Money received from fines given for those people convicted of domestic violence crimes.		
<b><u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u></b> The funds remaining in this fund upon abolishment are to be split 50/50 between the Domestic Violence Restraining Order Reimbursement Fund (0641) and the Domestic Violence Fund (0642) per Chapter 707/98.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> This fund available upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded-</b> Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from fines and penalties.		
<b><u>Comments/ Historical Information</u></b> This fund was abolished effective January 1, 1999 per Chapter 707/98 and Penal Code 1203.097.
