<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Federal grants, gifts, donations, subventions, rent, royalties, leases and proceeds from the sale, exchange or transfer of lands		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Continuously appropriated		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from federal proceeds.
