<u>Purpose</u> For removal or remedial actions to be performed at a specific site.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Toxic Substances Control/Org 3960		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Funds received from a settlement agreement or the General Fund.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25330.4 (e), at the conclusion of all removal or remedial actions at the specific site, any unexpended funds in any subaccounts established pursuant to this section shall be transferred to the subaccount for site operation and maintenance established pursuant to Section 25330.5, if necessary, for those activities at the site, or, if not needed for site operation and maintenance at the site, to the Toxic Substances Control Account.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Section 25330.4(b) of the Health and Safety Code provides that the funds deposited in the Removal and Remedial Action Account are continuously appropriated to the Department of Toxic Substances Control for the purposes specified.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded - The major revenue source is transferred from another fund, which has already been counted in an included fund, the General Fund, and should not be double-counted.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> On April 4, 2004, an administrative decision was made to omit reference to the parent fund, found at the end of the title.
