<u>Purpose</u> Amounts deposited in this fund are used to support the Access for Infants and Mothers Program which provides health care assistance to low income pregnant women who qualify.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Subscriber contribution		
<u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Notwithstanding Government Code section 13340, the fund is continuously appropriated, without regard to fiscal years.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded - The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted in an included or always excluded fund, the Cigarette and Tobacco Products Surtax Fund (#230), and should not be double counted.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 278, Statutes of 1991 (AB 99) created this fund. Chapter 195, Statutes of 1994 (AB 816) revised the revenue source pursuant to Insurance Code section 12699 subdivision (b). December 2013 revision changed the Administering Agency from the Managed Risk Medical Insurance Board/Org 4280 to Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260.
