<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To distribute vehicle license fee moneys for the administration of various social service programs. In accordance with the Welfare and Institutions Code section 17600 (c), funds are provided to local agencies though the following subaccounts within this fund: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) The Mental Health Subaccount – Fund 3278.</li> <li>(2) The Social Services Subaccount – Fund 3274.</li> <li>(3) The Health Subaccount – Fund 3279.</li> <li>(4) The CalWORKs Maintenance of Effort Subaccount – Fund 3276.</li> <li>(5) The Family Support Subaccount – Fund 3281.</li> <li>(6) The Child Poverty and Family Supplemental Support Subaccount – Fund 3282.</li> <li>(7) The County Medical Services Program Subaccount – Fund 3275.</li> </ol>		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> State - Local Realignment/Org 5195		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Vehicle license fees		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Continuously appropriated		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – The major revenues source is transferred from another fund, which has already been counted in an included fund, Local Revenue Fund (0330), and should not be double counted.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 20, Statutes of 2015 continued the existence of this fund effective June 24, 2015 and added seven new funds, also known as subaccounts, within this fund.
