Purpose

This fund was created to deposit the fees that cities and counties are required to collect from each applicant for a building permit, for seismic hazards mapping and for the strong-motion instrumentation program.

Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)

Pursuant to Government Code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.

Appropriation Authority

The money in this fund is available upon appropriation by the Legislature.

State Appropriations Limit

Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.

Comments/Historical Information

Chapter 240, Statutes of 2003 (AB 1747), renamed this fund from the Seismic Hazards Identification Fund to the Strong-Motion Instrumentation and Seismic Hazards Mapping Fund, effective July 1, 2004.
