<u>Purpose</u> For the purpose of funding disbursements made for response to and recovery from the earthquake, aftershocks, and any other related casualty.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> California Emergency Management Agency/Org 0690		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> A 1/4 cent increase in the sales tax and a corresponding increase in the use tax, from December 1, 1989 to December 31, 1990, inclusive.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Government Code section 16419 provides that the fund is continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal years.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Included – Revenues in this fund are proceeds of taxes which are included as SAL revenues. The major revenue source from this fund does not have a logical, direct relationship between the use or purposes and the payers from whom it was collected.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Administering organization change from 0695 to 0690 effective 11/4/04. Per Chapter 372, Statutes of 2008, the Office of Emergency Services and the Office of Homeland Security are merged to form the California Emergency Management Agency.
