<u>Purpose</u> To defray the costs of data entry and system management for the Veterans Registry.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Veterans Affairs/Org 8955		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Financial Contributions.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Notwithstanding Government Code section 13340, the money in the fund is continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal years.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded- Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 300, Statutes of 1997 abolished related Fund 0488 (Veterans Memorial Account) which was used to construct the memorial on State Capitol grounds. December 1998 revision changed the administering agency from the Veterans Memorial Commission/Org 8975 to Department of Veterans Affairs/Org 8950. August 2014 revision changed the administering agency organization code from 8950 to 8955.
