<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> Mobilehome-Manufactured Home Revolving Fund

<b><u>Purpose</u></b> This fund was created as a depository for fees received for the enforcement and administration of provisions of law related to mobile homes. The state enforces construction standards pursuant to the National Mobile Home Construction and Safety Standards Act of 1974 and makes inspections to insure compliance. In addition, the state is responsible for the adoption and enforcement of regulations regarding commercial coaches and recreational vehicles. Fees collected will pay for the cost of administration and enforcement of state and federal laws and regulations pertaining to mobile homes. If the amount of money in the fund exceeds the amount needed for operating expenses on June 30 of each fiscal year, the schedule of fees is reduced to offset the excess money.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Housing and Community Development/Org 2240		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Statutory and fees established by the Department of Housing and Community Development.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Section 18016.5 of the Health and Safety Code provides that "Money transferred to, or deposited in, the fund is continuously appropriated to the department notwithstanding Section 13340 of the Government Code, for expenditure in carrying out the provisions of this part."		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not the proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred may become proceeds of taxes.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 846, Statutes of 1973 created the Mobile Home Revolving Fund. Chapter 975, Statutes of 1981 changed the name of the fund to the Mobilehome-Manufactured Home Revolving Fund.
