<u>Purpose</u> This fund is a depository for funds to pay for dental treatment of a child by a primary care clinic pursuant to Section 1189.109(b)(2) of the Health and Safety Code.			
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Health Services/Org 4260			
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Section 69 of Chapter 51, Statutes of 1990 provides for the appropriation of \$500,000 from the Unallocated Account in the Cigarette and Tobacco Products Surtax Fund for expenditure in fiscal year 1990-91.			
<u>Disposition of Fund</u> Costs of dental treatment of children by primary care clinics, pursuant to Section 1189.110 of the Health and Safety Code.			
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Funds will be available upon appropriation by the Legislature.			
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded —Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund. (Non-Federal)			
<u>Comments/ Historical Information</u> The legislation that created this fund was repealed pursuant to Chapter 415, Statutes of 1995 (SB 1360). Therefore, this fund is abolished effective January 1, 1996.
