<b><u>Purpose</u></b> Designing, selecting, purchasing, constructing, and furnishing a permanent residence for the Governor.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of General Services/ Org 1760		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Transfer of existing funds in the Governor's Mansion Account within Special Deposit Fund 0942034.		
<b><u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Section 8174, proceeds of the sale shall be deposited into a special account and held for the purpose of providing a "suitable residence" for the Governor.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> -- The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which will be counted in an always excluded fund, Governor's Mansion Account within the Special Deposit Fund (0942), and should not be double counted.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 732, Statutes of 1999, repealed Section 8175 (c) of the Government Code, by its own terms, effective January 1, 2003. Therefore, this fund is abolished effective January 1, 2003.
