<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To provide the legally blind certificated classroom teachers employed by the applicant with the services of a reader for a maximum of 15 hours per school week.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Education/Org 6100		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Transfers from the General Fund.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Pursuant to Education Code section 45371 the Superintendent of Public Instruction shall allocate to each applicant school district a sufficient amount for the fund's purpose.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted in an included fund, the General Fund (0001), and should not be double counted; as well as this fund is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal).		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> August 2014 revision changed the administering agency organization code from 6110 to 6100.
