<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Nongovernmental/Trust and Agency Funds-- Non-Federal	
<u>Purpose</u> Created as a depository for transfers received from the State Lottery Fund resulting from revenues from the sale of state lottery tickets or shares.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> State Controller's Office/Org 0840		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Transfers from the State Lottery Fund.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Government Code section 8880.5 provides that the fund is continuously appropriated.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which will be counted in an always excluded fund, the State Lottery Fund (0562), and should not be double counted; as well, as this fund is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal).		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Proposition 37, approved by the voters in the November 6, 1984 election, created this fund. Chapter 2, Statutes of 2009 (AB 2XXXX) amended this fund by adding subdivision designations (a)(1) and (a)(2) to Government Code section 8880.5. Chapter 589, Statutes of 2012 Amendment substituted “State Department of Mental Health” for State Department of State Hospitals” in subdivision (h).
