<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> State Employees' Dental Care Fund

<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>GAAP Basis</u></b> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>Legal Basis</u></b> Nongovernmental/Trust and Agency Funds-- Non-Federal	
<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To pay dental claims and other administrative costs, as specified. For self-funded dental care plans for state employees other than employees of the California State University.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Personnel Administration/Org 8380		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Funds appropriated by the Legislature for the purposes of self-funded dental care plans.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Identifiable contributions would be refunded to the contributors; any remaining balance would be transferred to the General Funds pursuant to Government Code section 16346.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Section 22952.1 of the Government Code provides that the moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal).		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Administratively abolished per Government Code section 13306(b), effective 2/6/2012.
